

## Dr Astrid Pavlovsky's Biography and Headshot



Astrid Pavlovsky was born in Buenos Aires, Argentina, graduated from Medical School with honors in 1997. She did her fellow in Internal Medicine in a prestigious University Hospital, Hospital Italiano, for 5 years and continued her training in FUNDALEU as a fellow in Hematology.

Since 2003 she is working as a staff in the onco hematology department in **FUNDALEU** where she also participates in different clinical investigational trials as principal investigator or co- investigator. She is Medical Director of an outpatient clinic dedicated only to hematological patients, **Centro de Hematologia Pavlovsky**.

She received the certificate of **Competence in Lymphomas from the ULM University in Germany in 2016**.

Since 2005 she has been an active member of **GATLA** (an Argentinean cooperative group) and is currently the **Chairman of the Adults group for Hematological Malignancies** and leading organizer of the **Lymphoma Working Group**.

She is involved in several educational activities including workshops and university courses.

Since 2011 she is involved as a speaker and discussant in the **European School of Oncology (ESO)** e-grounds for on line education and later joined de Lymphoma Hub to promote hematological knowledge. She is also part of the internacional organizing comitee of the International T cell Proyect and chair of the Latin America Registry.

Since 2017 she is being part of the Advisory board of the **International Congress on Malignant Lymphomas** held in Lugano, Switzerland and is editor of the Annals of Lymphoma.

Since 2019 she is part of the International Committee of the T Cell Project, now leading a **Latin American T cell Registry** with more than 7 countries actively participating.

Since 2019 she collaborated with **NCCN guidelines** and is currently a reviewer in different journals in Oncohematology and has been an author and co-author in several national and international journals with a special interest in Lymphomas.

Since 2020 she is part of the **steering Committee of Women in Lymphomas** and of **the Lymphoma Hub**

In 2021 she was invited to review and re-write **WHO classification on Lymphomas** as part of the clinical Advisory Committee.

Has actively participated as a speaker in international meetings like ICML, EHA, Myeloma and Lymphoma and is highly committed with educational lectures on Lymphomas in meetings around all of Latin America.

She participates as Principal Investigator or Sub-investigator in different clinical trials for Lymphomas and CLL and has published as author or co-author in different journals.
